2025 Staffing and Classes

27 classes confirmed at this stage for 2025 however we are hoping for 28 classes if enrolment numbers increase slightly.

Teachers have been drafted to classes. No new teachers joining CCNPS in 2025.

As we did in 2024, we will continue to utilise all learning spaces across the school where possible.

School Behaviour Support and Management Plan (SBSMP) for CCNPS

- The senior executive presented the final draft of the plan along with an analysis of the parent and teacher feedback. We also explained the process used for gathering key information from our K-6 students regarding the behaviours they consider most inappropriate within our school and our community. This thorough approach ensures that we are addressing the concerns and experiences of all stakeholders involved. This feedback will also be shared in the upcoming newsletter.
- The School Behaviour Support and Management Plan (SBSMP) document will be ready to be published to our school website on the first day back for students in 2025. In working to improve our processes for teachers in supporting students behaviour and strengthening our work with parents, we will also have an updated 'Behaviour Flowchart' to accompany this document.

Other P&C Matters:

- Update on the school crossing on Playfair Road – The council have advised that this crossing will be upgraded in the next allocation of finances in 2025 and will become a raised crossing.
- The Anxiety Project – Positive parent feedback has been received which will be highlighted in the 2024 Annual School Report. Approx. 40 resources have been loaned to parents.
- Cudal to Curly – this was a successful visit that will be highlighted in our newsletter.
- The Manly Warringah Netball Club have reached out to the school to start a discussion about leasing carparks under a community user agreement. This discussion will occur prior to the winter netball season.
