2025 Organisation

- We were able to start the year with 28 classes. 716 students and 62 staff.
- We haven't had any new staff join our team this year
- RFF programs this year include Music (Mrs Hoffman), PE (Mrs Le'Estrange and Mrs St Pierre), STEM (Mrs Auton) and Library (Mrs Turner and Mrs Auton)
- In addition to school sport, we are also able to offer PSSA Summer sports for this term and I want to acknowledge the teachers who volunteer on top of their teaching time to take on the coach role for these sports.
 - Summer PSSA Sports (Boys Oz Tag, Girls Oz Tag, AFL, Cricket, Volleyball & Softball)
 - School sport program will also run at this time.
- Voluntary School Contribution - The voluntary school contribution will remain capped at \$51 p/student.

School Behaviour Support and Management Plan (SBSMP) for CCNPS

- The School Behaviour Support and Management Plan (SBSMP) document has been published to our school website and was highlighted in our first newsletter of the year.
- There has been positive feedback already on the updated 'Behaviour Flowchart' which accompanies this document with consistency in student understanding of our behaviour expectations and in how inappropriate behaviour is managed.

CCNPS House Name

- Initial consultation with the staff has occurred in regard to updated school house names to replace our current Cook, Flinders, Phillip and Bass. Early this term we will start consulting more with our students and families before looking at ways to engage our wider school community in working through this change process.

Other P&C Matters:

- NBSC Freshwater Open Day - Year 6 Families – There will be an Open Day for 2026 Year 7 students who will be attending NBSC Freshwater on 25 March 2025 2pm – 3pm. For Year 6 students attending and being signed out of school early, this will be recorded as School Business. This will be communicated by email to all Year 6 families this week.
- School Wishlist – this is currently being drafted. This year we will need to start replacing the interactive whiteboards across the school which are all out of the warranty period and now starting to have issues beyond repair. We are also considering a climbing rope frame for installation in top playground in addition to supporting teaching and learning resources for each stage.
